The purpose and scope of this policy statement

At Music in Unison, we are committed to protecting the privacy and security of your personal information. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and share your information when you use our website and services.

Why we collect your data

We collect your personal information to provide our classes and services to you and your child(ren). We need to know your name, contact details, and your child's age and name to ensure the class is appropriate and to prepare labels for them. We also ask for information about any medical conditions your child may have to ensure their safety during the class. Your phone number is optional but enables us to contact you if needed. When you make a payment, we use a third-party payment provider (Stripe) that requires your details to verify your card. We do not retain this information.

Who we share your data with:

We share your personal information with third-party companies who help us process the data, such as our website host (Wix) and payment provider (Stripe).

Updating and deleting your information
